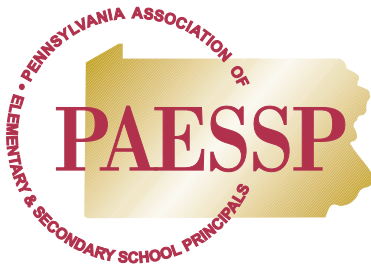
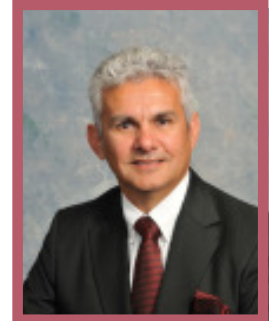


BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Dr. Paul M. Healey is the **executive director** of the Pennsylvania Association of Elementary and Secondary School Principals (PAESSP). His experience as a teacher, assistant principal, principal, director of education and superintendent has prepared him to lead the association into the future.

For most of his 33 years in public education, Dr. Healey has served in the role as an elementary principal. In addition, he has acted as an assistant superintendent, superintendent and as an adjunct professor and staff member for Penn State Harrisburg. Over the past six years, he has also served in the non-profit sector as a board member for the Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development (ASCD) and was elected president in 2011 as the only Pennsylvania educator to serve in this role for this 145,000-member educational organization.

Dr. Healey began working at PAESSP in July 2013 and replaced former executive director, Dr. William Hartman, Jr., when he retired in June 2014.
