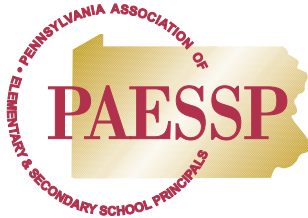

She began her career as an administrator as an intermediate/middle school assistant principal in the Schuylkill Valley School District. Since then, she served as an assistant principal and principal at Schuylkill Valley Elementary School in the Schuylkill Valley School District; Limerick Elementary School in the Spring-Ford Area School District; and at the Evans Elementary School, also in the Spring-Ford Area School District.

Ms. Havrilla received a bachelor of arts degree in early childhood education from Point Park University. She also received masters' of science degrees in secondary guidance and rehabilitation counseling from the University of Scranton, and her K-12 administration certification from Bucknell University.
